-  Indian Trails Thruway motorcoach connection. Coaches are normally not accessible to passengers who use wheelchairs. Thruway connections provide coordinated train/motorcoach service with guaranteed connections, as well as through fares and ticketing. Passengers traveling on Thruway connections must be ticketed before boarding coach in order to obtain through fares. Tickets may be purchased at Amtrak stations, travel agencies or via ticket-by-mail.
-  Ticket office open for all train departures.
-  Ticket office/checked baggage not open for all departures.


 Tickets can not be purchased at this location.

 All station facilities are fully accessible to persons using wheelchairs.
